OF JEFFERSON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 4**



In accordance with the Texas Attorney General’s opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners.
4. Discuss debarment of Labelle-Fannett VFD from government procurement and non-procurement programs and issues relating to same.
5. Discuss insurance coverage issues relating to the 2015 Pierce Tanker recently purchased by the District.
6. Review, discuss and take action on financial statements and compilation for 2014-15 fiscal year to be submitted for audit, and retention of an independent accountant to conduct the District’s 2014-15 audit and prepare an audit report.
7. VFDs Chiefs’ Reports; review and discuss Monthly Run Reports and other records submitted by the VFDs.
8. District Manager’s Report.
9. Review and approve minutes of the February 15, 2016 regular meeting.
10. Treasurer’s Report.
11. Review, discuss and take action to approve and authorize payment of the District’s bills and accounts; and, review, discuss and take action to approve VFDs’ emergency expenditures being submitted for reimbursement and authorize payment of same.

Review, discuss and take action on proposed purchases of equipment and/or supplies, proposed equipment repairs, maintenance and/or testing, as well as any purchase, repair, and/or maintenance requests submitted by the VFDs, including, but not limited to, accessories for recently purchased 2015 Pierce Tanker and extrication tools for Cheek VFD.
13. Discuss feasibility of the District and/or departments providing full-time paid EMS services within the District, and alternative options, including, but not limited to, contracting with a private EMS service provider.

15. Such other matters that may come before the board.
