
**NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING AND AGENDA

Regular Meeting

1. Call to order.
2. Determination of quorum.
3. Public comment. In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners.
4. Discuss federal debarment of Labelle-Fannett VFD and issues relating to same, as well as the District's contractual relationship with Labelle-Fannett VFD for providing fire protection and emergency medical services, and take any needed action in relation to same as well as any matters necessary to ensure continued fire protection and emergency medical services for the District.
5. Review, discuss and take action on the District's financial statements and compilation for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2015.
6. Review, discuss and take action to retain an accountant to perform the District's fiscal year 2014-15 audit.
7. Such other matters that may come before the board.
8. Adjourn.
