OF JEFFERSON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 4**



6. Review and approve minutes of the October 19, 2015 regular meeting.
7. Review, discuss and take action to approve the District's 2015 Certified Tax Roll.
8. Treasurer's Report.
9. Review, discuss and take action to approve and authorize payment of the District's bills and accounts; and, review, discuss and take action to approve VFDs' emergency expenditures being submitted for reimbursement and authorize payment of same.
10. Review, discuss and take action on proposed purchases of equipment and/or supplies, proposed equipment repairs, maintenance and/or testing, as well as any other purchase, repair, and/or maintenance requests submitted by the VFDs.
