Notice is hereby given that a Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Jefferson County Emergency Services District No. 4 will be held on December 15, 2014, beginning at 5:30 p.m., at the Labelle-Fannett VFD Fire Station, located at 12880 FM 365, Beaumont, Texas 77705, for the following purposes:

**Regular Meeting**

1. Call to order.
2. Determination of quorum.
3. Public comment. In accordance with the Texas Attorney General’s opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners.
4. VFDs Chiefs’ Reports; review and discuss Monthly Run Reports and financial/billing reports submitted by the VFDs.
5. Review and approve minutes of the November 18, 2014 regular meeting.
6. Treasurer’s Report.
7. Review, discuss and take action to approve and authorize payment of the District’s bills and accounts; and, review, discuss and take action to approve VFDs’ current operation and maintenance expenditures being submitted for payment by the District, and authorize payment of same.
8. Review and discuss any equipment repair, replacement, and/or acquisition proposals being submitted by the VFDs, and take any needed action.
9. Discuss acquisition of used ambulance by the District and take any needed action in relation thereto.
10. Discuss accounting-related policies and procedures for the District, including, but not limited to, a general purchasing and procurement policy, VFD expenditure payment/reimbursement policy, fraud policy, credit card use policy, travel reimbursement policy, as well as accounting-related consulting services and creation of an administrative staff position for the District, and take any needed action.

- 11. Discuss inventory of the District and VFDs' equipment and assets, and take any needed action.
- 12. Discuss and take action regarding Records Management Program, including Order establishing same; appointment of Records Management Officer and Public Information Coordinator; and, Declaration of Compliance with Records Scheduling Requirement of the Local Government Records Act.
- 13. Discuss and take action to approve 2014 Certified Tax Roll pursuant to request from the Jefferson County Tax Assessor-Collector.
- 14. Discuss and take any needed action regarding retention of an independent accountant to perform District's annual audit for fiscal year 2013-14 and prepare report for same.
- 15. Review and discuss Labelle-Fannett VFD's training policy and procedures for firefighters and medics.
- 16. Counsel report regarding activities since last board meeting; and, advise Board on the annual report to be submitted to the Texas Department of Agriculture – Office of Rural Affairs pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code § 775.083, publishing of the District's administrative office address and new regular meeting date in accordance with Tex. Health & Safety Code § 775.036(f), request for reappointment of Board members with terms of office expiring on January 1, 2015 pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code § 775.034(b), and status of the Board members' training and continuing education requirements set forth in Tex. Health & Safety Code § 775.0365.
- 17. Such other matters that may come before the board.
- 18. Adjourn.
